Documents needed for admission application*

For a master's degree:

- Complete academic records
- For a master's degree that involves research only, an outline of the proposed master's research
- Copy of passport or birth certificate
- CV

For a doctoral degree:

- Complete academic records
- Outline of proposed doctoral research (3–5 pages)
- Copy of passport or birth certificate

*Applicants for programmes in the College of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences need to complete a departmental questionnaire.

*Applicants for programmes in the College of Science, Engineering and Technology need to first contact professors in the college and get a confirmation letter that should be uploaded together with other documents at the time of online application.

*If you are admitted, you will be required to get your qualification evaluated by the South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA) and submit the certificate of evaluation to Unisa within your 1st year of registration.
