

Process flow for Recognition of Structures

The process flow was derived from the Directive: Recognition of Student Organisation and Structures. The purpose of this document is to clarify and simplify the recognition process.

Steps to be follow:

- 1. NSRC to issue an invite to student structures to apply for recognition through the Secretariat office
- 2. Structures prepare to submit application which are in line to Section 9.1 of Recognition of Student Organisations.
- 3. Application to NSRC Secretariat office:
 - Structures send their application to the regional Secretary and Regional Education and Training officer
 - Regional Secretary and Regional Education and Training officer compile all received applications, send them to the NSRC Secretariat Office and Copy the National Education and Training officer
- 4. NSRC Secretariat Office with the assistance of the National Education and Training officer compile all the applications received in preparation for NSRC meeting
- 5. NSRC meet to review the applications and forward recommendation to the Deputy Director Student Development
- 6. Deputy Director Student Development communicate the outcomes of recognition to the structures
- 7. In a case where a structure is not satisfied with the outcomes with reason(s) provided, the structure may write to Dean of Students to appeal the outcomes.
