ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

ASSESSMENT

Assessment is made based on the submission of individual and group assignments together with a portfolio of evidence.

ON COMPLETION

On successful completion of the programme, students will receive the Leading for Innovation Certificate from the Unisa Graduate School of Business Leadership (SBL), an internationally respected educational institution.
